

CONDITION OF BVS TRAILS

Updated 1/13/2017

PLEASE DO NOT RIDE ON ANY OF THE TRAILS AFTER RAIN OR SNOW UNTIL THEY ARE DRY. THIS CAUSES DAMAGE TO THE TRAILS.

- ◆ A **CLOSED TRAIL** – Trail in its present condition is not suitable to ride. Trail may be disrupted due to excessive erosion; it may be blocked by boulders or downed trees; trail surface may be saturated and subject to failure. **Riding wet trails tears them up making riding difficult for others who follow (after they dry out and hoof print divots harden).**
- ◆ **Additionally, all trails should only be ridden if they are dry. If muddy – stay off!**
- ◆ A **PASSABLE TRAIL**: Trail may be used. Some minor obstacles may be present. Riders should know how to get their horse through such obstacles. Some of these trails are not recommended for inexperienced riders or equines
- ◆ Do not pony horses on trails unless you can teach them to follow behind you and your horse, not next to you.
